

Craft tip: Rattles from lightbulbs



What will you need?

- Blancol paste
- Water
- Bowl
- Brush
- 1 old light bulb
- ½ old light bulb
- Sheet kite paper



1. Sprinkle 1 unit in weight of Blancol paste onto 9 units in weight of cold water, stirring constantly.



6. Brush the first layer again with paste (do not re-immers) and cover completely with paper snippets once more. Repeat this procedure as often as necessary until you have used up all the paper snippets.



2. Stir the paste continuously so that it can develop full effectiveness.



7. Allow the light bulb to dry well. This will take about 2 days in the ambient air. (Tip: the plates will dry faster in an oven with the door open, at a max temp. of 50°C, but this will naturally use up a lot of energy)



3. Cut the kite paper into snippets.



8. Hit the light bulb with a pair of scissors, so that it breaks inside.



4. Dip the light bulb in the paste.



9. ... **and your rattles are ready!**
(Keep away from small children)



5. Use a brush to cover the light bulb completely with the first layer of paper snippets, then allow to dry.

Note:

You can also make music by pasting over yoghurt pots filled with rice or peas.
