

Craft tip: Easter Nest made of papier-mâché

What will you need?

- Blancol paste
- Bowls of various sizes
- Clear film
- Coloured tissue paper (1 sheet is enough for 1 bowl with 20cm diameter)
- Feathers or shredded paper in a suitable colour
- Paintbrush

Instructions

Cover the bowls with clear film. Tear the tissue paper into pieces measuring about 4 cm². Mix the paste with water according to the instructions on the packaging. Dampen the bowls with paste and stick some of the pieces of paper around them (see Fig. 1).



Use the paintbrush to add more paste; soak paper in the paste and then smooth it on. Repeat this process until you achieve a layer about 2 mm thick. Allow to dry overnight. Lift the papier-mâché out of the bowls and peel the clear film off carefully (see Fig. 2).



Put in some feathers or shredded paper and fill with Easter treats ... ***your Easter Nests are now ready!***
